

The new (2017) Slot.it wheel coding system (easier than the Enigma machine)

The new code carries all the information about the wheel, starting from the three important dimensions (diameter, width, hub thickness), then adding some further information about the design type.

For example, our old code for wheel WH1110-A1 is 17.3mm diameter, 8.2mm width, 1.5mm hub: it becomes **W17308215A**:

W is for wheel

173 is the diameter in mm $(17.3 \rightarrow 173)$


082 is the width in mm $(8.2 \rightarrow 082)$

15 is the hub thickness in mm $(1.5 \rightarrow 15)$

A for aluminium

The last letter (in this example, 'A'), indicates the wheel type:

A	Aluminium, Standard Design	
M	Magnesium, Standard Design	6
P	Plastic, Standard design	00
АН	Aluminium, Double Shoulder with Holes	
AF	Aluminium, Double Shoulder without Holes	6



All dimensions are in mm

We believe that this change will make things easier for everyone - even if we understand that there will be some initial perplexity.

To minimize this, the stickers on the bags will carry BOTH old and new codes at least initially Effective January 2017 all Slot.it wheels will be coded according to this rule.
