The Slot.it Audi R8C 1/32 model slot car is a race thoroughbred, but it is an accurate reproduction of the car and its history, through six different liveries, portraying its various development steps. The Audi R8C made its first, and only, race appearance at Le Mans in 1999. Unveiled only three weeks before qualifying, designed by Tony Southgate, it is surely one of the most beautiful racing cars ever seen at Le Mans. It featured a carbon fibre chassis and body, a 3600 cc turbo powered engine, and a 6 speed sequential gearbox. Both cars retired during the race, due to gearbox problems.
